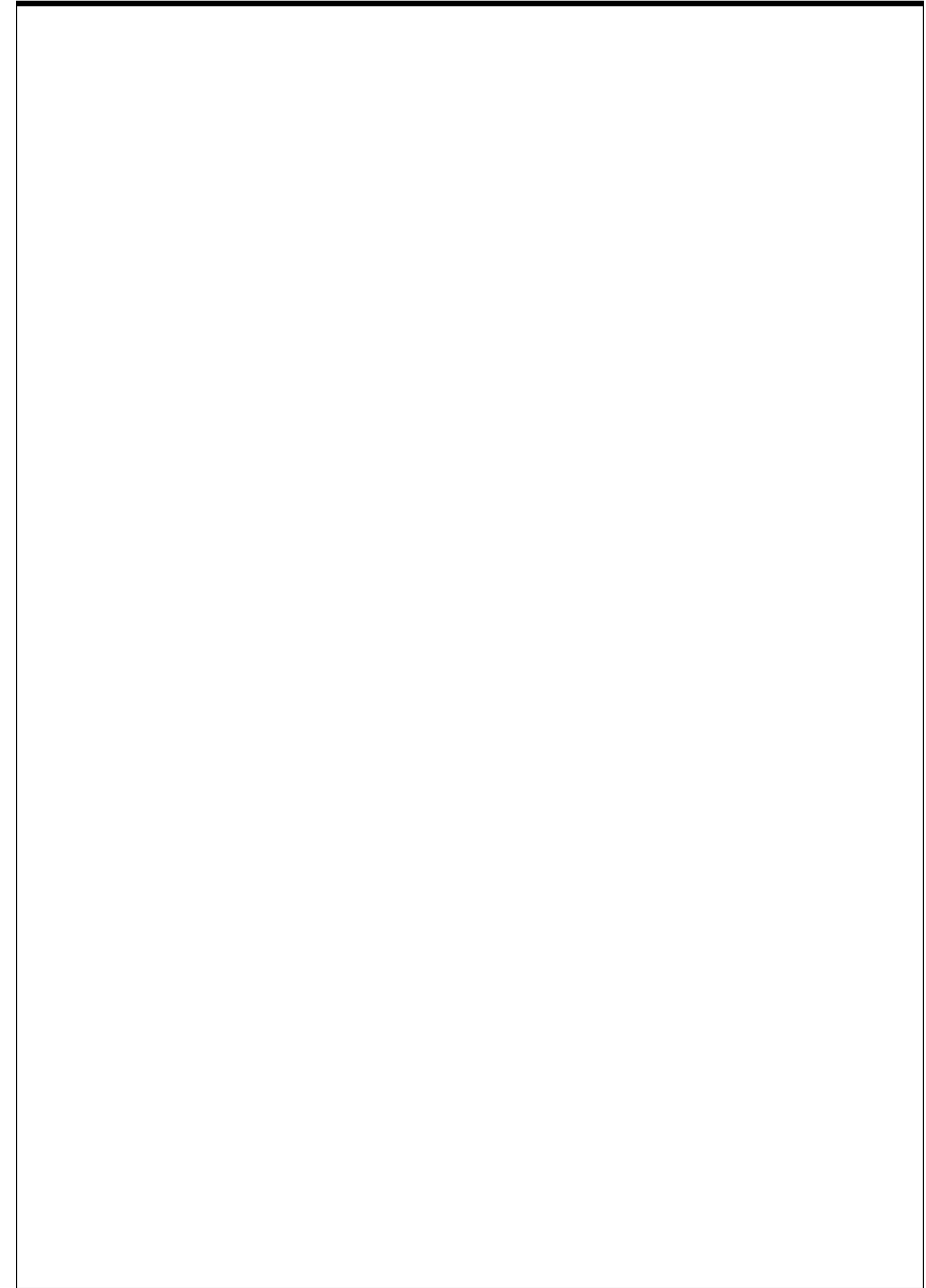

LEAs with Title IV Part A allocations of \$30,000 or greater will still be required to write at least one investment in each Title IVA content area, but with no minimum spending requirements in each. LEAs with allocations of less than \$30,000 will still be required to write an investment in at least one content area.
