Many months have passed since your school participated in the 2011 National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) assessment. I want to thank you again for your participation in the 2011 NAEP assessment. As I told you in March, the assessment results in reading and math for Vermont would be released in the fall. The results were released on Tuesday, November 1st.

The results are reported for Vermont public school students at grades 4 and 8. These are state results only as there are no school or individual student results. Many of you told me that some parents had expressed interest in the results so I created a snapshot report of the results just for them. It is a one page document, grade specific, that you can distribute at your discretion.
