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FY 2004 Vermont Teacher/Staff Full-time Equivalent (FTE) and Salary Report Executive Summary

Purpose

The FY 2004 Vermont Teacher/Staff Report presents data on student/teacher ratios, teacher and staff FTEs, and salaries in the elementary and secondary school system. These data are used to calculate class size and average salaries in Vermont, and are reported to the National Center for Education Statistics and to the Vermont School Boards Association.

Data used in this report were collected in the Vermont Department of Education's 2003-2004 Fall Data Collection. This collection is designed to gather information on students, teachers and staff in each of the state's 312 public schools, 5 "public acting" independent schools, and 60 supervisory districts/unions.

For the purposes of this report the term "school" will be used in reference to the responding public and public acting schools which submitted data.

FY 2004 Teacher and Support Staff FTEs

Vermont public schools and supervisory unions reported a total of 18,786.88 FTE teachers and support staff, compared to 18,753.07 in FY 2003. The number of FTEs providing direct instructional services decreased to 12,965.88 in FY 2004 from 13,045.73 in FY 2003. In FY 2003 direct instructional services accounted for 69.57% of the FTEs for all school and supervisory union staff. In FY 2004 direct instructional services FTEs decreased to 69.02%. FY2004 is the third year that vocational teacher FTEs were collected separately. They account for 2.30% of direct instruction.

Women fill the majority of direct instructional positions in Vermont. For FY 2004, 71.5% of the teachers and 91.1% of the teacher aides are female. Administrative positions are predominantly male. In FY 2004, 55.7% of the principals and 68.4% of the superintendents are male.

FY 2004 Student/Teacher Ratios

For FY 2004, Vermont's average student/teacher ratio is 11.72, compared to 11.69 in FY 2003. Student/teacher ratios ranged from 2.10 to 17.78. Vermont's student/teacher ratio is below the National Center for Education Statistics national average *projected for FY 2002 of 15.9*.

FY 2004 Teacher and Teacher Aide Salaries per Full-time Equivalent

In FY 2004, the average classroom teacher salary in Vermont is \$41,692.27, an increase of \$380 or .92% from the FY 2003 average. In FY 2003 there was an increase of 5.5% and in FY 2002 there was an increase of 2.40%. According to the most recent data available from the National Center for Education Statistics, Vermont ranked 28th out of 50 states on average teacher salaries for FY 2000. The average teacher aide salary in FY 2004 is \$13,093.79. This is an increase of \$691 or 5.57% from the FY 2003 average.

FY 2004 Teacher/Staff Full-time Equivalent (FTE)

Purpose

Table 1 presents by category the total number of teachers and support staff employed in Vermont schools and supervisory unions. These categories are consistent with the national standard and are defined below. Further definitions can be found in the *Handbook for Financial Accounting of Vermont School Systems: Financial Code Classification System*.

Direct Instructional Services (Function 1000):

Activities dealing directly with the interaction between teachers and students.

Student Support Services (Function 2100):

Activities designed to assess and improve the well being of students and to supplement the teaching process.

Instructional Staff Support Services (Function 2200):

Activities designed to assist the instructional staff with the content and process of providing learning experiences for students.

General Administration Support Services (Function 2300):

Activities concerned with establishing and administering responsibility for a school or group of schools.

School Administration Support Services (Function 2400):

Activities concerned with the overall administrative responsibility for a school or group of schools.

Business Support Services (Function 2500):

Activities related to paying, transporting, and maintaining goods and services for the school system. Included are the fiscal and internal services necessary to operate the school system.

Operation and Maintenance of Plant Services (Function 2600):

Activities concerned with keeping the physical plant open, comfortable and safe for use, and for keeping the grounds, buildings and equipment in effective working condition and state of repair. This includes safety activities.

Student Transportation Services (Function 2700):

Activities related to the transportation of students to and from school, and co-curricular activities.

Central Support Services (Function 2900):

Activities other than those classified under General Administration (2300), which support the other instructional and supporting services programs.

Food Services Operations (Function 3100):

Activities conducted in order to provide food to students and staff.

Summary

School and supervisory union employees filled a total of 18,786.88 full-time equivalent positions in FY 2004. This figure represents an increase of .32% over last year's total of 18,753.07 FTEs. In FY 2003 there was an increase of 2.6% over FY 2002, from FY 2001 to FY 2002 there was an increase of .97% and from FY 2000 to FY 2001 there was an increase of 3.69%.

In FY 2004, over two-thirds (12,965.88 or 69%) of school and supervisory FTE employees provide direct instructional support. Just under half (46%) are classroom or ungraded teachers. These figures are consistent with those reported in previous years. Table 1 provides a breakdown of educational staff in Vermont schools and supervisory unions.

Purpose

Figures 1a-b illustrates the percentage of Teachers and Teacher Aides FTEs reported under Function 1000 and employed in Vermont schools and supervisory unions. Figure 1c represents total percentages.

Summary

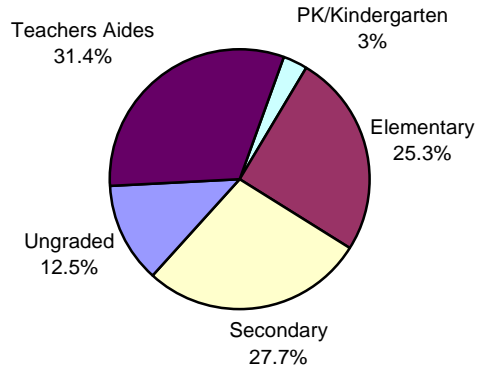
Figure 1a shows that 25.3% of all direct instructional FTEs working in Vermont schools in FY 2004 are in the elementary teacher category. Slightly more, 27.7% are in the secondary teacher category, and an additional 31.4% are in the teacher aide category. The remaining direct instructional FTEs are employed as ungraded classroom teachers and preschool/pre-kindergarten teachers.

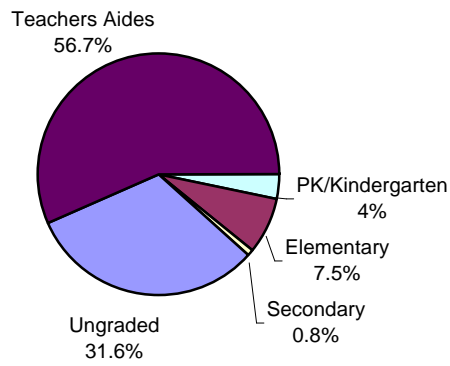
Figure 1c shows that the state totals for direct instructional FTEs are 33.3% in the teacher aide category, 24% are in the elementary teacher category and 25.7% are in the secondary teacher category. Compared to FY 2003 the total percentage of direct instructional FTEs employed as elementary teachers, secondary teachers, and teacher aides has virtually remained the same. In FY 2003 teacher aides held 31.6% of total instructional FTE positions, while elementary teachers held 23.6% and secondary teachers held 26.1%.

Figure 1b shows that just over half (56.7%) of all direct instructional FTEs working in supervisory unions are teacher aides. Approximately one-third (31.6%) are ungraded teachers, the remainder teach pre-kindergarten through 12 grades.

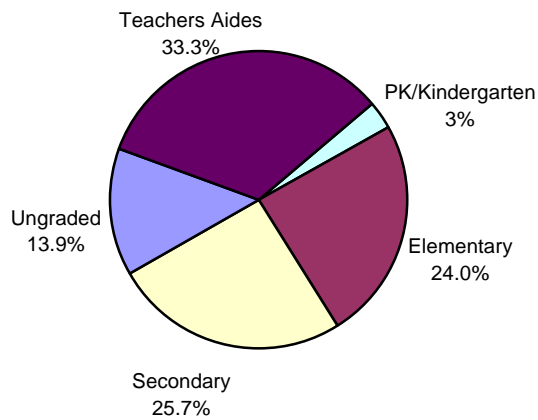

Purpose

Table 2 provides a breakdown of teacher and staff FTE by function and gender.

Summary

Nearly three-quarters (743%) of FTE employees in Vermont public schools and supervisory unions are female. In positions providing direct instruction, 71.6% of all teachers are female and 91.1% of the teacher aides are female. Males continue to hold the majority of principle positions (55.7%) and superintendent positions (68.4%). Men also hold the majority of positions in transportation (61.5%) and maintenance and security positions (80.5%). These figures are consistent with those reported in FY 2003.

Purpose

Table 3 lists student/teacher ratios for each school and supervisory union in Vermont. This ratio describes the relationship between the number of enrolled students and the number of full-time equivalent (FTE) teachers. The FTE count used to determine this ratio includes regular classroom teachers as well as those teachers who do not have regular classroom assignments but have teaching responsibilities such as art, music, or special education. Student/teacher ratios can provide information about teacher workload as well as the amount of individual attention that might be available to students.

Student/Teacher Ratio Calculation

The student/teacher ratio was calculated by dividing FY 2004 student enrollment by the FY 2004 teacher FTE count in each school or supervisory union. In order to maintain consistency with the National Education Association's standards for student/teacher ratio report, student enrollment (October 1 headcount) was used as the numerator rather than the student FTE count. The denominator includes preschool/pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, elementary, secondary, and ungraded teacher FTEs. Vocational teachers were not included in this year's student/teacher ratio. In previous years, schools that operated technical centers included vocational teachers in their teacher FTE counts, which resulted in their student/teacher ratios being lower than other high schools.

FTE teachers employed by supervisory unions have also been included in the student/teacher ratios listed in Table 3. These FTEs may include ungraded classroom teachers who are employed by, but do not actually teach at, a supervisory union. Typically these are teachers who travel between two or more schools during the week, providing services for students with special needs or unusual circumstances. For this reason some supervisory unions may report teacher FTEs with no student enrollment. Supervisory unions which report both teacher FTEs and student enrollment are typically operating special education, Essential Early Education (EEE), or pre-kindergarten programs.

Summary

For FY 2004, Vermont's average student/teacher ratio is 11.72, compared to 11.69 in FY 2003. The declining student/teacher ratio could be attributable to a decline in overall enrollment. Student/teacher ratios ranged from 2.10 to 17.78. Vermont's student/teacher ratio is below the National Center for Education Statistics national average projected for FY 2002 of 15.9.¹

Purpose

Table 4 lists average teacher and teacher aide salaries by school and supervisory union. Average Salaries were calculated by dividing the total salary dollars by the total number of FTEs.

Summary

Schools in FY 2004 pay an average (mean) teacher salary of \$41,692.27 and an average teacher aide salary of \$12,991.95. The minimum school average teacher salary is \$21,257.52 and the maximum school average teacher salary is \$64,922.63. The minimum school average teacher aide salary is \$6,627.33 and the maximum school average teacher aide salary is \$19,065.93.

In FY 2004 the statewide average teacher salary (for schools and supervisory unions) is \$43,009.15, an increase of \$1,697.51 or 4.10% from the FY 2003 average. In FY 2003 there was an increase of 5.47% and in FY 2002 there was an increase of 2.38%. According to the most recent data available from the National Center for Education Statistics, Vermont ranked 29th out of 50 states on average teacher salaries for FY 2001.²

The statewide average teacher aide salary in FY 2004 is \$13,093.79. This is an increase of \$690.87 or 5.28% from the FY 2003 average.
