Vermont School Custodian of the Year - 2011

For the third year, the Vermont School Custodians and Maintenance Association (VSCMA), together with the Vermont Department of Education, would like to identify and celebrate an individual as Vermont School Custodian of the Year.

Principals, superintendents, and school board chairs are invited to nominate professional school custodians. Qualified individuals will be current full-time school custodians who have served in a Vermont school for at least five years and who exemplify the positive qualities of a hard-working, dedicated member of their school team. A committee comprised of the VSCMA officers and representatives from the Department of Education will review nominations and select a deserving custodian for recognition prior to the end of the 2010-2011 school year.

The 2010 recipient of the Custodian of the Year award was Jean Brooks from the Jamaica Village School. Ms. Brooks was recognized for her diligence, dedication, and professionalism at the 53rd Annual School Plant Operations and Maintenance Conference on June 24, 2010 at Hartford High School.

Nominations for the 2011 Custodian of the Year award should be in the form of a letter from principals, superintendents, and/or school board chairs detailing the nominee's strengths, accomplishments, and contribution to her/his school team.
