**INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS WHO HAVE COMPLETED  
POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION OUT OF COUNTRY**

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for contacting the Vermont Department of Education's Office of Educator Licensing. You have indicated that you have completed your postsecondary education outside of the United States. Your process begins with these three steps. After you have completed these steps we will be able to determine your licensing route to becoming a Vermont educator.

**Step 1**

Vermont educator licensing regulations require that those who have completed their academic preparation outside of the United States must have their credentials evaluated by a credentials evaluation service. Please select one of the following to order a Credentials Report:

**Note** Vermont requires two (2) types of foreign transcript analysis:

- General Evaluation, and
- A Course-By-Course Evaluation

You must request both of these analyses. Please request that an official copy of the results be sent from the organization to: Vermont Department of Education, Office of Education Licensing, 120 State Street, Montpelier, Vermont 05620-2501. **Next, you must immediately complete Step 2!**

### **Step 2**

- Send a cover letter with your name, address, and Social Security Number to the Office of Educator Licensing, requesting that the department perform a transcript analysis when your Credentials Report is received in our office.
- State which organization is conducting the Credentials Report and the date the review was requested.
- Submit \$40.00 (US Funds) for this review. Make checks payable to the Vermont DOE Licensing Office.

If you have followed Step 1 and Step 2, we can begin your review as soon as the report is received. Incomplete requests will be returned to the applicant.

### **Step 3**

Vermont licensing policy also requires that you show study in the following areas. This study may have been included in your college education, U.S. citizenship classes or other forms of study. You must provide evidence of:

- General knowledge of American history and culture.
- Coursework in the education of the exceptional child (special education).
