- o 1. The Immigrant Children and Youth grant funds will be used to meet the cost of providing the authorized supplementary educational services to immigrant students.
- o 2. The administering agency, after consultation with appropriate officials, shall provide for the benefit of students enrolled in nonpublic schools secular, neutral, and nonideological services, materials, and equipment necessary for the education of immigrant children and youth enrolled in the nonpublic elementary or secondary schools.
- o 3. The control of Immigrant Children and Youth grant funds and the title to any materials, equipment, and property repaired, remodeled, or constructed with these funds shall be in an administrating agency for the uses and purposes provided in this application.
- o 4. The provisions of services to immigrant children and youth enrolled in programs, elementary and secondary schools, shall be provided by employees of an administrating agency or through contract by that agency with a person, association, agency, or corporation who or which, in the provision of such services, is independent of that agency and of any religious organization; and any employment or contract shall be under the control and supervision of the administrating agency, and these funds shall not be commingled with federal, state, local funds, or private funds.
- o 5. The agency shall submit periodic reports that may be requested by the VT DOE and shall provide the DOE or federal government with information or records requested relative to the expenditures of the Immigrant Children and Youth grant funds and/or services rendered. The agency shall attend department scheduled meetings.
- o 6. Programs and services offered will be conducted in accordance with all federal, state, and local laws and all requirements set forth in policies and procedures as issued by the Vermont Department of Education.
