

## Basic NCLB Info by the Numbers

### Transferability

- 0% Percent of funds that may be transferred from Title I.
- 0% Percent of funds that may be transferred by Local Education Agencies (LEAs) that are both the fiscal and accountability LEA and are in “corrective action” status of LEA improvement
- 30% Maximum percent that may be transferred from Titles IIA, IID, IV, V if an LEA that is both the fiscal and accountability LEA are in year one or two of LEA improvement status
- 50% Amount LEAs may transfer of their yearly allocation from titles IIA, IID, IV and V if the LEA is not identified for improvement

### Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)

- 1 “Year 1” of not meeting Adequate Yearly Progress (referred to as “1<sup>st</sup> Checkmark”)
- 2 “Year 2” of not meeting Adequate Yearly Progress (referred to as “1<sup>st</sup> year of school improvement or 2<sup>nd</sup> checkmark”)
- 3 “Year 3” of not meeting Adequate Yearly Progress (referred to as “2<sup>nd</sup> year of school improvement”)
- 4 “Year 4” of not meeting Adequate Yearly Progress (referred to as being in “Corrective Action”)
- 10% The percent of Title I funds a school must spend on professional development (focused on the areas causing identification) if a Title I school is identified
- 10% The percent of its Title I allocation an LEA must spend on professional development if a single district LEA is identified as in need of improvement, and is both the fiscal and accountability LEA
- 20% Maximum LEA obligation of Title I, Part A funds (inclusive of other funding sources) for schools that reach “2<sup>nd</sup> year of school improvement” to be used for Supplemental Education Services (SES) and/or choice related transportation
- 20% Maximum obligation required to spend of Title I allocation (inclusive of other funding sources) for transportation for choice in 1<sup>st</sup> year of school improvement

Administration limits

2%	Maximum amount of annual Title IV allocation that may be used for Administration
5%	Maximum amount of annual Title IID allocation that may be used for Administration
8%	Maximum amount of annual Title IIA allocation that may be used for Administration
10%	Maximum amount of annual Title V allocation that may be used for Administration
10%	Maximum amount of annual Title I allocation that may be used for Administration

Miscellaneous

15%	Maximum percentage of allowable Title I carryover of the previous year's Title I allocation. Must be reached by September 30 (15 months after the beginning of the program year in which the allocation occurred).
25%	Percent of IID funds that must be used for technology oriented professional development
25%	Percent of carryforward from Title IV that can be carried forward without approval from the VTDOE.
30 days	Number of days notice given to VTDOE of intent to transfer between titles before doing so.
100%	Amount of carryforward that must be spent by September 30 each year (on 27 month old funding) or it returns to the federal Treasury.
