NSLP After School Snack Program 50% List 2010-2011*

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) After School Snack Program is designed to give students a nutritional boost and draw them into after-school activities that are safe, fun, and educational. School Food Authorities that participate in the National School Lunch Program and offer after-school care programs with educational and enrichment activities in a structured and supervised environment are eligible to participate and receive reimbursement for snacks served.

The information in this report shows all the schools in Vermont that had at least 50% of student enrollment eligible for free or reduced price school meals (based on October 31, 2009 eligibility data on file with the Vermont Department of Education, Child Nutrition Programs). One use for this data is to determine site or area eligibility for NSLP After School Snack programs started between February 1, 2010 and February 1, 2011. (For more information on use of this data for the NSLP After School Snack Program, see the material at the bottom of this page.) Any school on this “Area vs. Site Eligibility List for The After School Snack Program” qualifies either the school building as an **eligible site** or a specific geographic area as an **eligible area** for the After School Snack Program.

1. Individual schools on the NSLP After School Snack Program 50% List 2010-2011 that serve all students in a community or are neighborhood schools that serve students within a specified attendance area can operate area eligible programs anywhere in the community or attendance area served by the school.
2. Any school on the NSLP After School Snack Program 50% List 2010-2011 that (1) is one of several schools in a community; (2) is not a neighborhood school; (3) does not serve all students in a particular grade range in a community; or (4) draws students from several towns (such as a Union High School) can operate a site eligible program located at that school building. If a Program is operated in a location other than the school, reimbursement must be claimed by free, reduced, and paid categories.

No students participating in area eligible or site eligible NSLP After School Snack Programs can be charged for snacks, regardless of individual eligibility, and the school will receive free reimbursement for each snack served to these students. Schools not listed in the NSLP After School Snack Program 50% List 2010-2011 will be reimbursed at the free, reduced price, and full-price rates for snacks based on individual student eligibility. Reimbursement rates are published each year in July. Reduced price eligible students can be charged up to \$.15. Schools determine the charge of full price students.

The list on the following pages is arranged by School Food Authority (SFA). To see if your school is on the list, first look for your school food authority, then check the eligible schools listed with the appropriate SFA. This data will tell you towns/cities/neighborhoods that are area eligible, as well as schools that are site eligible.

*The following describes how these numbers can be used:

- The percentages in the list on pages 3-9, apply to any After School Snack Program started **after February 1, 2010** and will continue to be valid through the end of the 10-11 school year.
- Programs sponsored by schools that were not on last year’s list (09-10), but appear on this list (10-11), may start claiming all snacks as “free” beginning with the February 2010 Claim for Reimbursement and continue to use this data through the 10-11 school year.
- Programs sponsored by schools that have been operating the after school snack program as area eligible based on prior year data but do not appear on this must start claiming after school snacks by category (free, reduced, and paid).
