Recommended Changes to Rule Series 2000, Education Quality Standards

Presentation to State Board of Education

March 20, 2024

Changes as a result of Act 1 (2019)

Act 1, "An act relating to ethnic and social equity studies standards for public schools"

- 1. Increase cultural competency of students in grades PK-12;
- 2. Increase attention to the history, contribution, and perspectives of ethnic and social groups;
- 3. Promote critical thinking regarding the history, contributions, and perspectives of ethnic and social groups;
- 4. Commit schools to eradicating racial bias in their curricula;
- 5. Provide, across their curricula, content and methods that enable students to safely explore questions of identity, race equality, and racism; and
- 6. Ensure that the basic curriculum and extracurricular programs are welcoming to all students and account for parental concerns about religion or culture (Act 1 of 2019, Section 1(g) Duties of the Working Group).

Process since SBE last review/approval

- May 2023: SBE voted unanimously to adopt the Rule 2000
- June/July 2023: ICAR presentation and formal filing
- September/October 2023: 3 Public Hearing 180 attendees
 - 100 written comments
 - Public Comment Period Closed October 25, 2023
- Nov 2023 Mar 2024: 12 EQS Committee Meetings
 - included 2 joint EQS/2200 meetings (Special SBE Meetings)
 - legal review
 - LCAR extension approved to June 5, 2024

Public Comment - General Categories

- Statement of Purpose
- Definitions
- Applicability to Independent Schools
- Curriculum/Learning Content
- Tiered Systems of Support

EQS Modifications since close of public comment:

- 1. Statement of Purpose modified to retain intention
- 2. Definitions:
 - 1. removed those that no longer appear in the document
 - 2. modified definition of discrimination
 - 3. removed those that are substantively defined in statute
 - 4. moved descriptive language into the body of the document where applicable
 - 5. included definitions for Agency and State Board
- 3. reorganize to move definitions up in the document, consolidate staffing requirements, bring tiered systems of support within instructional practices
- 4. clarify SU/SD and level of governance throughout the document
- 5. Effective date: July 1, 2025 and AOE support for implementation
- 6. legal/technical considerations and other clarifications
