
• Indicator 2 examines the percent of youth with IEPs dropping out of high school.



Measurement

• Measurement: % of exiting youth w/ IEPS age 14-21 who dropped out (rather than graduated, aged out, or received a certificate)

Youth with IEPs Ages 14-21 who exited school during the year: **10 of 50 exiting students dropped out: 10** ÷ **50** = **20%** received certificate




Rationale and Parameters
