### Dual Enrollment - First Generation Students

The following table shows the real number and percentage increase of First Generation college students who participated in dual enrollment opportunities over the past two years.

A First Generation student is defined as a student with one parent (or both parents) who lacks a four-year college degree. In addition to the participation numbers below, First Generation students who completed courses with a grade of C or better rose from 54% in FY13 to 74% FY14.
