Item: ROPA Report on Champlain College New Math Program

ITEM: Shall the VSBPE grant conditional approval of Champlain College's new Middle

Grades and Secondary Math programs for two years?

AGENCY RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the VSBPE grants conditional approval of Champlain College's new Middle Grades and Secondary Math programs for two years with a Two-Year Report due in March of 2022.

BACKGROUND: The VSBPE approved Champlain's application to have a review of its proposed new Middle Grades and Secondary Math programs. On January 22, a team of educators approved by Champlain and the Board visited Champlain and interviewed a variety of people involved with the new programs. The team reviewed the evidence that Champlain had submitted, focusing especially on how the program will ensure candidates have met the endorsement standards. As Champlain already has approved programs in Middle Grades and Secondary English and Social Studies and had a successful ROPA review of those programs in April of 2017, the team drew on the ROPA Report from that review for many of the indicators.

RATIONALE: As noted in the ROPA Report, the team had two stipulations that needed to be met prior to the recommendation for approval. That Report was sent to Champlain and on Feb. 17, they sent documentation of how they have addressed those stipulations. Their new evidence was reviewed by the Chair of the team, Amy Saks-Pavese, and by ROPA Coordinator Ellen Cairns, and both found the evidence to be adequate to change the recommendation to approval of the program.
