Act 28 (2021)	An act related to improving prekindergarten through grade 12 literacy with the state
Act 173 (2018)	An act related to enhancing the effectiveness, availability, and equity of services provided to students who require additional support
Act 139 (2024)	An act relating to supporting Vermont's young readers through evidence-based literacy instruction

VPA	Funds for training & instructional materials (including funds for substitute teachers if needed for training)	
VISA	Resources & funding for instructional practices & assessment, professional learning on instructional practices & assessment	
VCSEA	Funds for professional learning	
VSA	Funds for instructional materials, funds for professional learning	
Literacy Community	Follow all parts of Act 139; Train teachers & administrators of criterion-referenced screening assessments, taking actions based on student's needs & continually monitoring progress
