# **Emergency Operation Plan Communication Package**

## **Purpose**

The Agency of Education's (AOE) Operations Team and Vermont School Safety Center continue to support all Vermont schools, including public school districts and approved and recognized Independent Schools, on Emergency Planning and Response. These efforts are critical to the operations for all schools. As we approach the winter weather season, please be reminded of the statutory requirements for all-hazards Emergency Operation Plan (EOP) and please take note of available state resources.

## **Statutory Requirements**

As a reminder, Act 29 of 2023 requires that all Vermont public and approved and recognized independent schools:

- Develop an EOP in collaboration with local emergency management partners and first responders. Please reach out to your <u>local emergency partners</u> to assist in the updating of your EOP.
- Maintain an EOP that is at least as comprehensive as the AOE-created created <u>All-Hazards Emergency Operations Plan Template.</u>
- You may choose to utilize the <u>All-Hazards Emergency Operations Planning</u>
  <u>Guide</u>, which serves as an accompanying guidance document to the Template.
- Have a completed EOP in place by July 1, 2024.\*
