The EPIC community would like to pilot some flexibility within the narrative portion of the VLP during this next academic year (23/24). Some examples of pilots are included below.

- Combining PCs in a single narrative (combine standards 4 and 5, both about content knowledge, address 7 and 8, planning with instructional strategies, etc)
- Including prompts for the writing narratives within the official VLP directions
- Considering other assessment types in addition to a written narrative (video, slideshow, artwork with audio, etc.)
- Responding to enhanced calls for the inclusion of equity across or in some PCs (for example, adding language to standard 2.2 to focus on DEIJB topics)
