BACKGROUND:

Middlebury submitted an application for a new program review of their postbac Modern and Classical Languages program; it was approved by the VSBE on November 29, 2023.

PROPOSED TEAM:

Ellen Emery will represent the educator preparation program field. Ellen is the director of the Teacher Apprenticeship Program (TAP) at Champlain College and a former Spanish teacher, as well as the current chair of the Program Approval Committee of the VSBE.

Matt Foster received his bachelor's and master's degrees in education as well as an MBA from Illinois State University, and a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies from the University of Illinois. He is currently the principal of Craftsbury School, and was the principal of Wolcott Elementary School prior to that. Matt was recently hired to be the superintendent of Caledonia Central Supervisory Union.
