The Prekindergarten Education Implementation Committee (PEIC) is charged with assisting the Agency of Education in improving and expanding accessible, affordable, and high-quality prekindergarten education for children on a full-day basis on or before July 1, 2026 by examining the delivery of prekindergarten education in Vermont and making recommendations to expand access for children through the public school system or private providers under contract with the school district, or both.
