I am emailing to express my great concern for the students at the Windham School. Although I do not have children that attend there, I am a taxpayer and I gladly pay my taxes especially for education, but only if it is worthwhile.

My concern is that the children are not receiving a quality education. I feel that the Windham School Board's objective is to keep the school operating disregarding the obstacles in securing certified teachers and absent a standardized curriculum.
