ITEM: Shall the VSBPE approve of the proposed ROPA review team for Champlain College's new program review?

AGENCY RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the VSBPE approves the proposed review team for Champlain College's new program ROPA review.

RATIONALE: The proposed team members have been approved by Champlain College. They are:

Amy Saks Pavese, Chairperson, is the Licensure Officer and Coordinator of the Master of Arts in Teaching program at Saint Michael's College, as well as a member of the faculty there. She received her B.A. and M.Ed. from the University of Notre Dame and her Ph.D. from the University of Colorado. Amy's areas of expertise are preparing teachers to work with culturally diverse students, educational foundations, and elementary math and science. She has taught Educational Foundations, Student Teaching Seminar, Integrated Curriculum, and Elementary Math and Science Methods courses, and also supervises student teachers.

Kaaren Meyer received her B.S. in Secondary Mathematics Education from the University of Vermont and her Masters for Teachers of Mathematics from the University of New Hampshire. She has taught math at Stowe Middle/High School since 1992, and is currently a Mathematics Teacher Leader and Instructional Coach. She has also served as a Peer Review panelist for educators seeking their math endorsement. And has served as an adjunct faculty member at Johnson State College and UVM. Kaaren holds a Level II license in both Secondary and Middle Grades Mathematics.

Chris Antonicci received his B.S. in Secondary Mathematics Education from the University of Vermont and his M.S. in Education Administration from Keene State

College. He has taught Middle Grades math and all subjects in a self-contained fifth grade classroom. Chris has served as the Principal of Union Memorial School since 2003, and has also served as a Peer Review panelist for educators seeking the Principal endorsement.

Christine Latulippe will represent the VSBPE on the team. Christine is a math educator at Norwich University, and has previously served on a ROPA review team.

Ellen Cairns will represent the AOE. Ellen is the ROPA Consultant and a former elementary school teacher.
