

Indicator 1: Graduation

$$\text{Indicator 1 Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of youth with IEPs in the current year's 6Y adjusted cohort graduating with a regular diploma}}{\text{Number of youth with IEPs in the current year's 6Y adjusted cohort eligible to graduate}} \times 100$$

The 6-year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate is reported in both the statewide and local APR. The adjusted cohort graduation rate is calculated by tracking the students from the time they enter grade nine. The total number of graduates is divided by the total number of students in the cohort. Students who transfer into the state (SU/SD for the local APR) are added to the cohort, while students who transfer out are dropped from the cohort.
