

Indicator 14: Post-Secondary Outcomes Information

- Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were:

$$\text{Indicator 14A Percentage} = \frac{\text{Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school.}}{\text{Number of respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school}} \times 100$$

- A. Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school.
- B. Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.

$$\text{Indicator 14B Percentage} = \frac{\text{Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.}}{\text{Number of respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school}} \times 100$$

- C. Enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school.

- This Indicator is related to how IEP students are doing one year after they exited high school.
- The information is gathered by SUNY via a telephone survey in which attempts are made to contact every student who exited high school in the prior year. Family members may respond as long as they are knowledgeable about the student.
