

Indicator 6: Early Childhood Environment

- A. The percent of IEP students ages 3 to 5 who are in a regular early childhood program and receiving the majority of special education and related services in the regular early childhood program.

$$\text{Indicator 6 Measure A Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children aged 3-5 in a regular early childhood program and receiving the majority of special education and related services in the regular early childhood program}}{\text{Total number of children aged 3-5 with IEPs}} \times 100$$

- B. The percent of IEP students ages 3 to 5 who are in separate special education class, separate school or residential facility.

$$\text{Indicator 6 Measure B Percentage} = \frac{\text{Number of children aged 3 to 5 in separate special education class, separate school or residential facility}}{\text{Total number of children aged 3-5 with IEPs}} \times 100$$

It should be noted that the sum of Sections A & B may be less than 100%, as there are other educational environments that are not the subject of these APR measures.
