Based on the Stipulation of Dismissal signed by the parties, on February 22, 2022; Special Education Due Process Hearing # 22-08 is hereby dismissed both with and without prejudice as per below:

The following claims, as listed in the Parent's Due Process complaint dated December 24, 2021 are hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUIDICE:

- Claim 1: School refused to establish a Section 504 Plan or IEP;
- Claim 3: School staff yelled at Student when he displayed disability-related behaviors;
- Claim 4: Student denied access to food at school;
- Claim 5: Student's behavioral plan was inappropriate;
- Claim 6: School refused to engage in education about Student's disability and how to meet his disability-related needs;
- Claim 7: School failed to appropriately respond to peer harassment and bullying of Student.

The following claim, as listed in the Parent's Due Process complaint dated December 24, 2021 is hereby DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUIDUICE:

• Claim 2: School inappropriately restrained Student on multiple occasions.
