- We have three sites that signed up for the summer pilot
 - King Street Center, Burlington
 - Missisquoi Valley Union High School, Swanton
 - Central Vermont Supervisory Union Williamstown and Northfield
- Waiting for confirmation from LEAPS (participated last year)
- WINGS interested in a fall pilot opportunity
- Training at the end of May includes curriculum that Katie has been working on, resources, potentially Advance VT and CCV; same expectations last year in providing both curriculum and community experiences for middle school students.



- Almost done with the guidebook, which includes 10 activities that are each 45 minutes to 1 hour to facilitate; very accessible and user friendly; slide format.
- Working on the community and guest speaker resources.
 - Tara can reach out for additional resources from CCV for access days/postsecondary information.
 - Katie will send the team the resources for review and feedback for our meeting next week.
 - Create protocol/guidance on how we ask employers about the visit what are we really asking for? Nat will work on drafting this.
- Katie met with Advance VT director, Tom Cheney He is working on Vermont Employment Pathfinder, which may be a great resource for those participating in the pilot.
