Merriam-Webster: <u>Videos About Words</u> (English Language Arts; all grades). This is a collection of videos about language usage and word history, including <u>how a word gets into the dictionary</u>.

Reading Rocket: <u>Root Words, Roots, and Affixes</u> (English Language Arts; all grades). This is an article containing charts of the most common Greek and Latin roots, prefixes, and suffixes.
