

# **FY24 Title IVA Progress on Objectives Report**

### **Purpose**

Colchester School District	Well-Rounded; Safe and Healthy Students; Effective Use of Technology	One of the Safe & Healthy Schools strategies, Equity PD, was canceled so the team was unable to attend and bring back information to school-based teams. The team used other equity resources but was unable to complete one of the strategies.  One of the Well Rounded strategies, EL/ML liaison, was advertised but we were unable to hire a liaison for grades K-5. The district was able to contract with an outside organization for liaison services for grades 6-12, but liaison support for the elementary grades went unmet.
Greater Rutland County Supervisory Union	Well-Rounded; Safe and Healthy Students; Effective Use of Technology	We struggled to engage schools in funding activities (WR & S & H) through Title IV this year as they also still had access to ESSER enrichment funding which required less paperwork and less advance planning. All targeted schools increased opportunities for students in these areas. Some schools were able to take advantage of the Title IV funds to do so - others used other funding sources.  Our EUT investment was not fully implemented due to lack of staff capacity to prioritize this work as planned after unexpected budget controversies began across the state and caused significant additional work for administrators and leadership teams.

Hartford School District	Effective Use of Technology	It was simply hard to find the time to incorporate additional professional development in digital literacy for teachers and challenging to add another thing to their already full plates.
Lamoille North Supervisory Union	Effective Use of Technology	Finding tech support providers and scheduling the learning proves to be very difficult. Either expertise is lacking, time is lacking, or both.
Mount Abraham Unified School District	Well-Rounded; Effective Use of Technology	Well-Rounded: We originally had an investment to send a team to Solution Tree's RTI Summit to provide professional learning, ideas and resources to further our MTSS as well as Equity and Inclusion work. Unfortunately, we were unable to get a representative team to commit to attending the experience as it was out of state and fell during our school vacation.  Technology: Our MakerSpace didn't require much by way of new technology equipment or new ways of integrating what we have so there were few expenses purchased from that area.
Rutland Northeast Supervisory Union	Effective Use of Technology	RE: Content Area 3: Effective Use of Technology - place of Powerschool Analytics, we purchased Educlimber through a different funding source. The Educlimber package that we chose included professional development.

St Johnsbury School District	Safe and Healthy Students	For the LEA's public school we met our expected outcomes, but our Independent schools did not meet some of their desired outcomes for Title IVA funds for one reason: they were unable to staff positions until later in the year. The work they intended to do to support Safe & Healthy Schools around SEL did not begin until the end of May 2024. Also, unable to staff their investment to hire a foreign language teacher as part of their Well Rounded investment.
Windham Central Supervisory Union	Effective Use of Technology	The person who took the PD left the district before completing the entire course which had to be paid for upfront. During their employment, they did apply skills from the course to improve data analysis and improve systems for data management.
