

Special Education Monitoring Cycle SY 2019 -2020



Although the previous monitoring system (compliance and graduation/drop out review conducted on a six year cycle) met the letter of the law, the Agency was not meeting the intention of the Office of Special Education Program’s (OSEP) guidance to really make a difference in improving outcomes for students with disabilities in Vermont. Beginning with school year 2019-2020, the former six-year monitoring cycle has been replaced with a three-year monitoring cycle.

The following local education agencies (LEAs) have been identified as participants for special education program monitoring activities for the 2019-2020 school year. Criteria for this year’s cycle includes all LEAs who have not received monitoring since the 2015-2016 school year as well as those identified for a site-visit based on monitoring activities for the 2018-2019 school year.
