School Age LRE Information

- A. The count of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are in the regular classroom for 80% or more of their day is divided by the total number of IEP students in the same age group.
- B. The count of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are in the regular classroom for less than 40% of their day is divided by the total number of IEP students in the same age group.
- C. The count of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are placed in Separate School, Residential or Homebound / Hospital settings is divided by the total number of IEP students in the same age group.

It should be noted that the sum of Sections A, B & C may be less than 100%, as there are other settings which are not reporting in the APR.
