## School Age LRE Information

A. The count of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are in the regular classroom for $80 \%$ or more of their day is divided by the total number of IEP students in the same age group.
B. The count of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are in the regular classroom for less than $40 \%$ of their day is divided by the total number of IEP students in the same age group.
C. The count of IEP students ages 6 to 21 who are placed in Separate School, Residential or Homebound / Hospital settings is divided by the total number of IEP students in the same age group.

It should be noted that the sum of Sections A, B \& C may be less than $100 \%$, as there are other settings which are not reporting in the APR.
