Parent Involvement Information

The data reported are acquired from surveys mailed to the parents of every child on an IEP in the State. There are two different surveys: one for the parents of children ages 3 to 5 and another for the parents of children ages 6 to 21. The results are combined for reporting purposes.

A pilot of this survey was conducted in 2005, obtaining responses from approximately 2700 in 6 states. The results of that pilot indicated that 17% of parents reported being involved in the special education process for their child. Vermont's results are consistently higher than this.
