

Dual Enrollment & Early College Rate Information FY23

Dual Enrollment

Dual Enrollment pricing levels include the following:

At the time of the dual enrollment course offering:

Type of Course	FY23 (Summer 22, Fall 22, Spring 23)
When the college pays the instructor, all colleges (except CCV) are reimbursed the CCV rate for dual enrollment courses.	Cost per credit (\$280) up to a 4-credit course. Most courses are 3 credits (\$840).
When CCV pays the instructor, CCV is reimbursed at 90% of their rate for CCV courses.	Cost per credit (\$252). Most courses are 3 credits (\$756).
When a course is taught by a high school instructor and the instructor is paid by the high school, participating colleges are reimbursed 20% of the CCV rate for dual enrollment.	Cost per credit (\$56). Most courses are 3 credits (\$168).

* These guidelines provide the current FY23 rates. Please note, the VSC Board determines the CCV tuition rate annually and rates may change for FY24.

Early College

Early College is reimbursed at 87% of the annual base education amount. For FY23 (the 2022-2023 academic year) the base education amount is \$11,247. Except for CCV, all participating colleges will be reimbursed \$9,785 for a full-time, two-semester student in FY23. CCV has an hourly tuition rate for Early College which, in total, cannot exceed \$9,785 for a full-time, two-semester student, although it can be less, depending on the number of hours.

This amount is intended to cover tuition for both semesters (one full year of Early College), not each semester.
