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## Vermont's Licensure Options for Providers of Supplemental Reading and/or Math Services

Anyone teaching in a Vermont public school must maintain a current Vermont educator license. However, Vermont does not have specific endorsements for those providing supplemental reading and/or math services. The chart below indicates the endorsements that are considered appropriate for these assignments. Any endorsement listed in the Appropriate Endorsements column is valid for either a supplemental reading or a supplemental math assignment for the corresponding grade levels. Please note that the instructional levels of the endorsement used must encompass the grade(s) taught in order to be appropriate for the assignment.
