SUBJECT: Peer Review Program – Panelists needed

DATE: 08/23/16

The <u>Peer Review Program is an alternative licensure program</u>. Applicants and potential educators demonstrate their readiness for licensure through professional and life experience as well as academic coursework. Over the course of several months candidates assemble a detailed portfolio that provides evidence of their experiences and academics, which have fulfilled all of the requisite Core teaching and endorsement standards.

The role of a Panelist is relatively small, but essential. To complete the Peer Review process and receive a recommendation the candidate must present her/his portfolio to a panel of educators who are licensed and experienced in the endorsement area they are seeking. The work of a panelist includes:

- 1. Reviewing and evaluating the Peer Review candidate's portfolio (you are sent all the materials for this prior to the Panel Interview so this can be completed at your convenience)
- 2. Participating in the Panel Interview for the candidate and post interview discussion. Panelists reach an agreement to grant a recommendation for licensure, or to deny the recommendation at this time. A denial will allow a candidate the opportunity to show additional evidence or create a Plan of Action to meet any defined deficiencies. (Panel Interviews last 1.5 2 hours total)
- 3. Follow up review of additional evidence or a Plan of Action to meet any deficiencies the Panel determines. (these materials are emailed to the panelists, so they may be reviewed in a timely manner at the panelists convenience)

Interviews are conducted at the Agency of Education building located at 219 North Main Street in Barre, VT typically from 4:00PM – 5:30-6:00PM (this may vary in the summer months). Compensation for serving as a Peer Review Program panelist includes a \$150.00 stipend and a Certificate of Attendance that awards each Panelist 4 hours of professional learning toward recertification for each Panel.
