

## FY '24 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers (21C) Competition Results

The 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers (21C) Program holds annual competitions for five-year investments that, in the aggregate, currently funds comprehensive afterschool and summer programs for 86 higher needs Vermont communities.

Competition results for the FY '24 cohort will distribute \$3,045,613 annually for each of five years to 11 projects in 39 sites. These projects proposed averaging 190 days of programming at sites serving 5184 youth annually.
