Application Details

- Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) this means supervisory unions/districts are eligible to apply.
- Applicants choose all or some of the following five strategies (strategy-specific details included in RFP): Curricula, School Health Policy, Cessation, Youth Engagement/Empowerment and Family Engagement.
- Applicants can apply for up to \$35,000 depending on how many strategies are chosen. The number and amount of awards depends on the number of successful applicants.
- Applications must be submitted through GMS. The RFP document is for reference and planning only.
- Central Data and other requirements of LEA must be finalized prior to submitting application. Superintendent or authorized representative must grant access to anyone working on grant (role/permission = "leatobacco")
