About: *The Cat in the Hat Knows a Lot About That!* is designed to spark a love of learning and an interest in science and engineering in preschool-aged children. Based on Random House's best-selling Beginner Book collection, "The Cat in the Hat's Learning Library™," the TV series and online resources are designed to cultivate positive views about science and scientists among the next generation and help families and teachers build communities of science explorers. Guided by the Cat, the children figure things out by engaging in science inquiry and engineering design. They ask questions and define problems, make observations and predictions, plan investigations, collect data, make discoveries, design solutions to problems, and generate and discuss ideas about how the world works.
