



Incorporating Vermont PBS Into Your Classroom

Program: Let Go Luna!

Grade(s): PreK-2

Ways to watch: <u>PBS Kids</u>, Vermont PBS broadcast stations, <u>PBS Kids app</u>, streaming services

About: *Let's Go Luna!* follows the adventures of three friends – Leo, a wombat from Australia; Carmen, a butterfly from Mexico; and Andy, a frog from the United States — as they traverse the globe with their parents' traveling performance troupe, "Circo Fabuloso." At each of the Circo's stops, Luna the Moon guides the trio as they get to know the local region and its people. The group's adventures take them through cities around the globe — from London to Cairo to Beijing — where they explore the food, music, art, architecture and other features that make each place distinctive. Episodes end with the kids back at the Circo Fabuloso and Luna back in the sky, with a reminder that there's always more to see, learn and experience in every place they visit.

1.	Inquiry	Children make sense of the world around them by actively gathering and interpreting information.
2.	Physical & Cultural Geography	Children construct concepts about the physical characteristics and locations of familiar to more distant places, and the impacts of people on the environment. They also construct concepts about their own cultural identity and learn to appreciate others' cultures.
3.	History	Children develop concepts about the passage of time, how the past has been interpreted, and the ability to connect the past with the present.
