About: Musician and early childhood educator Chris Dorman stars as *Mister Chris*, a delightful farmer and performer who makes wishes and leads children on adventures to learn more about how wishes might come true. Along the way, he meets up with friends and finds clues that help him to explore the topic at hand. Each episode is imbued with music and movement, with a strong focus on social and emotional development. *Mister Chris and Friends* emphasizes children's experience, expression, and management of emotions and the ability to establish positive and rewarding relationships with others. *Mister Chris and Friends* invites young children to play, explore, and learn. Multiple Emmy nominated, and <u>2020 winner</u>.
