# Indicator 8

- Percent of parents who report that the school facilitated parent involvement.

# Indicator 8 Measurement

- Percent of total respondent parents who report schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with disabilities divided by the total number of respondent parents and multiplied by 100.

# Considerations

Areas of consideration in target setting for Indicator 8:

- Number of respondents matters
- Number of respondents reporting involvement matters most
- Representativeness of respondents needs to be reported

# Number of respondents

FFY19 reporting data:

- Surveys distributed to parents of children with disabilities: 14981
- Responses from parents: 1677 (11.19%)

# Indicator 8 Historical Data

Total number of respondent parents of children with disabilities	1677	1160	910	1151

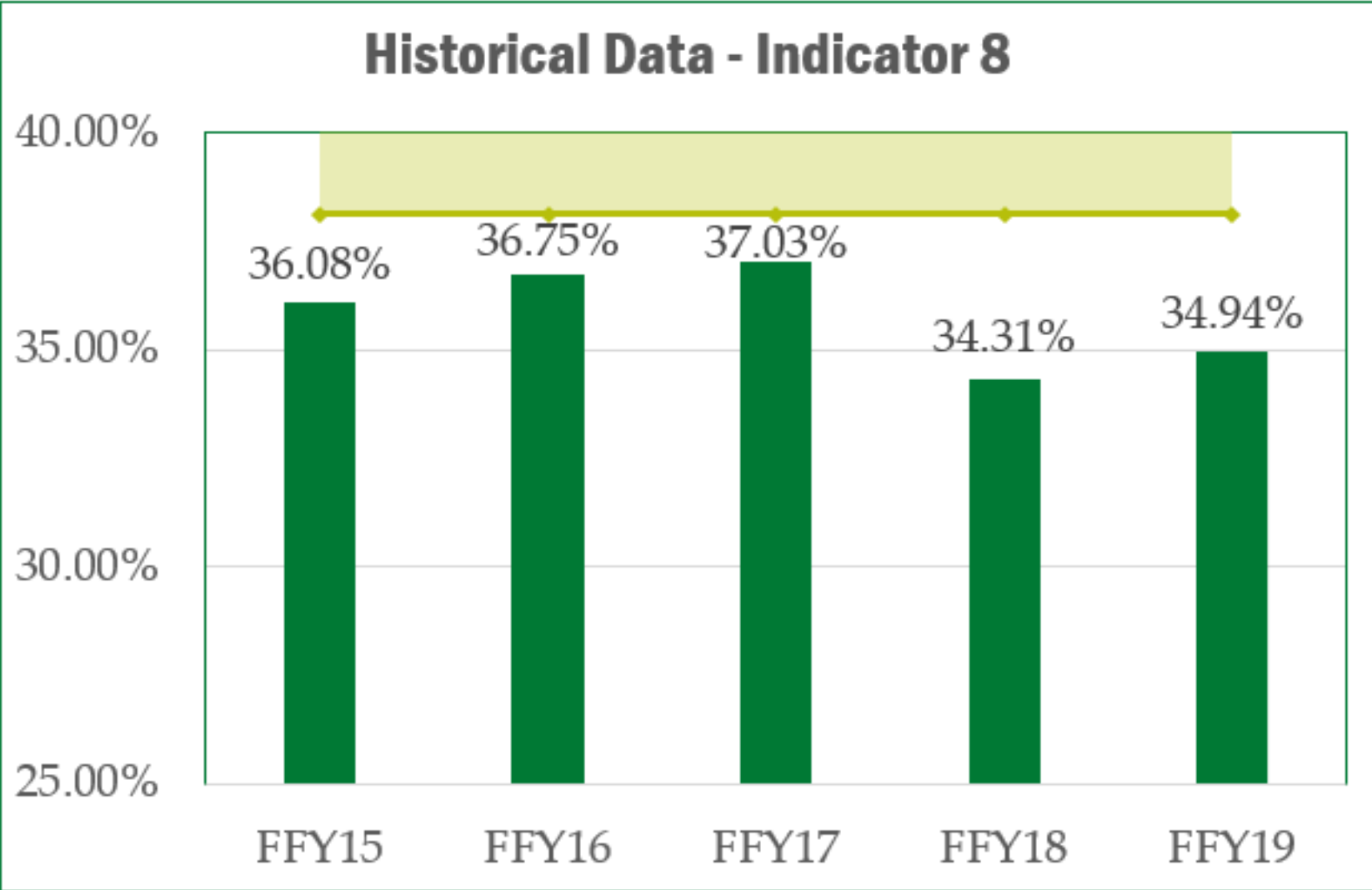
# Parents Reporting Involvement

- Percent : Number of respondent parents who report schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with disabilities divided by the total number of respondent parents multiplied by 100.

For example –In this year’s reporting data:

- 586 of 1677 respondent parents report schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with disabilities.
- For FFY2019 that means 34.94% of all those who responded

# Representativeness

- Required to analyze the extent to which the demographics of the children for whom parents responded to the surveys are representative of the entire population in Vermont.
- The AOE is required to include race and ethnicity
- And at least one of the following:
  - Age of student
  - Disability category
  - Gender
  - Geographic location
  - Or another category approved through stakeholder input
