

Instructions to Special Education Forms

Form 6b – Part C to Part B Transition



For children who receive Part C/Children’s Integrated Services/Early Intervention (CIS/EI) and are approaching their third birthday, Form 6B is completed by a school district early childhood special educator or designee during the 90 day transition meeting. Form 6B is used to guide discussion with family and CIS/EI staff and to verify evidence that is necessary for school district to determine if the child is eligible to receive Part B Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) and/or related services once the child turns 3 years of age. If a child is determined eligible to receive ECSE services, Form 6B requires written parental consent for Part B placement as well as consent for the initial provision of services once the IEP is developed prior to the child’s third birthday.
