This document provides a list of possible questions for students to ask Governor Scott during VPR's June 5th kids' press conference. The purpose is to provide a framework for thoughtful and engaging questions for elementary students to ask the Governor during this session.

Question Bank

- Where and when were you born?
- Where else have you lived?
- How old were you when you decided that you wanted to be governor?
- What kind of education do you need to become the governor or a politician?
- Did your family encourage you? Anyone else?
- Did you have any other occupations? If so, what?
- If you've had other jobs, what happened to change it?
- Why did you want to be the governor?
- What does your work tell us about what you care for?
- What work of yours is your favorite and why?
- What have you learned about Vermont since becoming governor?
- Do you ever make mistakes? What do you do then?
- Do you know other governors?
- How do you campaign? How do you get people to vote for you?
- Who are your role models? Why?
- Are there any important politicians whom you have met?
- What would you like to be remembered for?
- Is there a story or incident that you would like to tell us?
- What do you want to do when you're done being governor?
- What do you like to do for fun?
