I understand that if I give consent to the release of such information this consent will remain in effect until it is revoked or the student reaches the age of 18 (after which the student must consent) or the student graduates. I understand that if I refuse to give consent, my refusal will only affect the billing for IEP medical services to Medicaid; my refusal does not relieve the school district of its responsibility to provide IEP services at no cost to me. I understand that I may revoke this consent to release information for Medicaid billing at any time; if I revoke this consent, it will apply to billing for services from that date forward.
