- All programs will also receive \$0.30 in state funds for each reduced-price breakfast.
- Public School School Food Authorities (SFAs) participating in Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) or Provision 2 will also receive \$1.76 in state funds for each paid breakfast.
- State-Approved Independent School SFAs participating in CEP or Provision 2 will receive \$1.76 in state funds for each paid breakfast served to publicly-funded students.
