“Drawing Noses”

Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? How does Pinkalicious try to learn how to draw noses?
- What is an art exhibition?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- Ask the expert - Pinkalicious wants to learn how to draw noses so she asks an expert. What are you an expert at? Kicking a soccer ball? Building a block tower? Write a paragraph explaining how to do an activity in your area of expertise.
