

Discussion Questions and Activities for *Pinkalicious*

“Pinkalicious”

Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? What happens when Pinkalicious eats too many pink cupcakes?
- What does Pinkalicious need to do to cure her “Pinkatitis”?
- Why isn’t being pink as much fun as Pinkalicious thought?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- Pinkalicious is thrilled to wake up pink, but she comes to realize that it isn’t as fun as she had thought it would be. Imagine something you think would be great (ice cream for every meal? summer weather all year?), then think about what would make it not as much fun as you thought. Write a story about the experience.

“Glitterizer”

Before Viewing

- What do you predict this story/program is going to be about? Why?

During Viewing

- Is the story matching your earlier predictions? Explain.
- What is the CONFLICT (main problem) in the story? Why isn’t Rafael happy about the glitter on his painting?

After Viewing (Writing and Creative Activities)

- What does Pinkalicious learn about asking before you do something? Have you ever had this experience?

- Write a dialogue (conversation between two or more people) between Pinkalicious and one other person as she asks to use the Glitterizer. What would the conversation between Pinkalicious and her mom be like? What about Rafael?
