# Ready for Kindergarten! Survey (R4K!S) 

2021-2022

February 2, 2023

Report to Supervisory Unions/Supervisory Districts issued by the Vermont Agency of Education

## Background

Since 2000, Vermont has gathered information on the readiness of students entering kindergarten by surveying kindergarten teachers about their students' knowledge and skills within the first six to ten weeks of school. The effort to measure school readiness is a collaborative project of the Vermont Agency of Education (AOE), the Department for Students and Families, and the Department of Health. Various surveys for assessing schools' readiness have been conducted since this effort began. The SY2022 Ready for Kindergarten! Survey (R4K!S) marks the minus sixth year of deployment of the survey instrument.

There are many interpretations of what constitutes "readiness." Vermont's concept of student readiness is multidimensional; it includes social and emotional development, communication, physical health, as well as cognitive development, knowledge, and approaches to learning (e.g., enthusiasm for learning, persistence, and curiosity). Vermont's concept also reflects the belief that "school readiness" is interactional: students need to be ready for schools, and schools need to be ready to accommodate the diverse needs of each and every child.
The R4K!S is not a direct assessment of students; rather it relies on the teacher's accumulated observational knowledge of the child developed during the first few weeks of kindergarten. The R4K!S, along with its scoring on readiness identification methods, is based on recommendations made as a result of an independent validity review conducted by the American Institutes for Research (AIR) in the spring of 2015. R4K!S data results comparisons made between SY2016 through SY2022 data are considered valid. It is important to note that readiness results prior to SY2016 are not recommended nor valid comparisons to the SY2016 through SY2022 results. Also, data comparisons for SY2016 through SY2022 should take into consideration the impact of COVID-19.

## SY 2021 COVID-19 Impact Statement

"The COVID-19 pandemic has profoundly disrupted schooling nationwide, raising serious concerns about the impact of the pandemic on children's learning, the ways online learning may be exacerbating racial inequities, and the need to balance the strong desire for in-person learning with the risks posed by the pandemic." (Bassok \& Shapiro, 2021). One of the most noticeable impacts was a significant drop in prekindergarten and kindergarten enrollments across the country and in Vermont. "Early-grade enrollment drops are troubling given the importance of early learning experiences for children's school readiness. High-quality experiences in the early grades have also been linked to reductions in special education placements and grade retention." (Bassok \& Shapiro, 2021). In VT, "schools will need considerable resources, time, and flexibility to assess the wide-ranging developmental needs of children and to target a host of needed supports. They will need to think creatively about how best to structure classrooms and learning experiences to meet the very divergent needs of children in the early grades-especially those youngest, most vulnerable learners who
missed out on learning opportunities at a uniquely critical moment in their development." (Bassok \& Shapiro, 2021).

## Key Facts about R4K!S Measure

During the fall of SY2022 the R4KIS was delivered through a secure online version of Microsoft Forms; teachers completed one survey per child under their instruction. The survey consisted of 34 items across the domains of "Physical Development and Health" (PDH), "Social and Emotional Development" (SED), "Approaches to Learning" (ATL), "Communication" (COM), and "Cognitive Development" (CD). To complete the survey, the teacher rates each child's skills as "beginning," "practicing," or "performing independently" on 28 items and judges if hunger, illness or fatigue inhibit the child's learning on the remaining six physical development and health-related items. Each student's name, gender, and date of birth collected by the survey are for data verification purposes. By matching the student's unique identifier with the October School Census data, the AOE is able to identify:

- The percentage of boys and girls surveyed.
- Whether each student participated in publicly funded prekindergarten education and for how long.
- The students eligible for Free and Reduced-Price Lunch (FRL).

In order to capture and differentiate kindergarten students' ability levels, the R4K!S uses a "Total Score Approach," a three-point scale at the item (question) level, and the adoption of a four-point scale for readiness identification. Domain scores are used comparatively, to generally identify areas of relative strength and weakness.

The Total Score Approach links a student's score to overall ability. A student identifies as ready if their overall, or "Total Score," places them within the "Practicing" or "Performing Independently" range. To further differentiate the large midrange of student ability resulting from the R4K!S scoring system, total scores are converted into four rating groups, where the central cutoff is the midrange of all items.

## R4K!S Scoring and Readiness Calculations

The R4K!S scoring method to determine readiness is as follows:
A three-point scale 1- "beginning," 2- "practicing," and 3- "performing independently" is used for item (question) scoring for all questions except the six in the Physical Development and Health domain. These Physical Development and Health domain questions are reported as 1 - "disagree," 2- "somewhat agree," and 3 - "strongly agree."

The "Total Score" refers to the total 3-point score, based on question responses across 32 items. The Total Score excludes two out of the six Physical Development and Health questions. Question 11, "...missing school due to illness or lack of physical health" and question 12, "...begins...well nourished," are collected for descriptive information only.

R4KIS uses a four-level scale to calculate overall readiness. Students whose Total Scores fall into categories three and four ("ready and practicing" and "ready and performing independently") are identified as ready.

In SY2022, 85.36\% of all students statewide identified as ready for kindergarten, with $64.0 \%$ being within category 4 - "ready and performing independently," and $21.0 \%$ being within category 3 - "ready and practicing."

## Developmental Domain Scores

Developmental domain scores are included in the report to provide a general sense of relative strengths and weaknesses at the supervisory district level. In the validation report, AIR recommended that developmental domain scores only be used to draw general comparisons between developmental domain levels and between the supervisory district and statewide scores. Totaling scores across developmental domains will not result in data that are useful for understanding readiness.

The 34 items on the R4K!S are clustered into five developmental domains:

1. Physical Development and Health- 6 items, two of which do not contribute to readiness score
2. Social-Emotional Development- 7 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
3. Approaches to Learning- 7 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
4. Communication- 3 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
5. Cognitive Development- 11 items, all of which contribute to readiness score

## Supervisory Union/District and Statewide R4KIS Results

Data in the following tables are based on the number of students for whom teachers submitted scores. Teachers did not submit scores for all students in all districts, so in many cases, the data do not reflect the entire student population or all of the schools in the state or a district.

These tables provide a summary of the characteristics of surveyed kindergarten students broken out by several demographic groups reporting statewide and supervisory union/district data.

The category, "Did Not Attend Prequalified Publicly Funded Pre-K" includes both students who attended preschool or childcare that was not publicly funded and those who did not attend preschool or childcare. Because this statistic includes both groups, definitive conclusions cannot be made concerning the effect of PreK attendance on readiness on the basis of this data.

Table cells reading "***" indicate the count of students is 11 or lower and the data has been suppressed to protect student identities and personally identified information.

Domain scores are included in the report to provide a general sense of relative strengths and weaknesses at the supervisory district level. In the validation report, AIR recommended that domain scores only be used to draw general comparisons between domain levels and between the supervisory district and statewide scores. Totaling scores across domains will not result in data that are useful for understanding readiness.

The 34 items on the R4K!S are clustered into five domains:

1. Physical Development and Health- 6 items, two of which do not contribute to readiness score
2. Social-Emotional Development- 7 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
3. Approaches to Learning-7 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
4. Communication-3 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
5. Cognitive Development-11 items, all of which contribute to readiness score
