Discussion of Indicator 14:

- Discussed getting data on students who are in the criminal justice system.
- How survey is distributed and ways to improve distribution/response.

Listing ideas to bring back to full SEAC panel in March:

Measure A:

- This percentage can be improved if AOE does a push for college and post-transitional planning amongst schools.
- Recommend increasing target every two years

Measure B:

- Recommend increasing SPP from 56% to 70%
- Recommend improving collaboration with outside agencies; VocRehab, designated county agencies, etc.

Measure C:

- Recommend increasing SPP 75% (from 72%) for 2 years, 77% for two years, 79% two years.

Survey Recommendations:

- When students graduate, ask them and/or guardian how the state will be able to get in contact with them
- Offer possible paper and online form for students to fill out
- Make surveys more accessible to individuals who have disabilities, less wording, plain language, less answers, etc.

Discussion on Indicator 15:

- Discussed concerns regarding a limited amount of complaints being filed.
- Discussed barriers getting in the way of families not filing complaints.

- Recommend more training and outreach regarding filing complaints.
- There needs to be a lot of steps taken prior to raising the target goal.
