

**At a Glance [IF 11.08.16 votes are final]**

Since July 1, 2015:

- Voters in **50** towns in 12 SUs: [**PLUS 8 = 58 towns – ANESU 5 / GISU 3**]
  - voted to merge **57** school districts into: [**PLUS 9 = 66 districts – ANESU 6 / GISU 3**]
    - **11** unified union school districts (PK-12) [**PLUS 2 = 13 UUSDs**]
    - **1** modified unified union school district (“MUUSD”)
- Voters in 3 SUs did not approve proposals to merge a total of 20 school districts: Addison-Rutland (5 towns Yes : 1 town No); Franklin NE (0Y : 5N); and Orleans Central (1Y: 6N) [**Plus 1 = 4 SUs – BSU**] [**PLUS 2 = 22 school districts – BISU / PLUS 1 = 23 school districts – South Hero**]

**Voters in Grand Isle School District approved proposal to stop operating / begin tuitioning students in two grades (7-8) (vote: 575 Y / 301N)**

Of the approximately 87,000 prekindergarten - grade12 students living in Vermont in the 2015-2016 academic year, **42,053** of them live (or will live) in a unified school district as follows: [**44, 074.85 students**]

- Unified school districts created since enactment of Act 46: **20,746** [**PLUS 2,021.85 = 22,767.85 students – ANESU 1,583 / GISU 438.85**]
- Mountain Town RED and Mount Mansfield MUUSD: **2,934**
- Existing Supervisory Districts (Burlington, Montpelier, etc.): **18,373**
