Hi Jeanne,

I hope you had a great weekend! Thanks for meeting to talk with us a few weeks ago- I finally have a chance to circle back a bit.

My hope is to confirm adequate capacity for potential matriculating Ripton students to Otter Valley Union Middle and High School on a tuition bases. We have about 5 student per grade with class sizes growing but not to more than about 10/grade.

The State Board of Education requires that we verify capacity at surrounding Middle and High Schools to be sure Ripton students will be able to attend a school that is in compliance with State rules and regulations.

I chose not to reach out to the principals associated with those schools, but if you think I should, let me know.
