## **BACKGROUND:**

At the January 9, 2018 meeting, the VSBPE requested that the AOE add the endorsement Driver and Traffic Safety Education (in-vehicle instruction only) to Rule 5231.7 due to a prior omission and to correspond with a Chart currently in Rule which lists endorsement areas for educators whose employment is not considered teaching practice.

For 2018 Rules:

## **Rule 5231.7**

5231.7 Applicants for: Educational Speech Language Pathology, School Psychologist, School Social Worker, School Nurse, Associate School Nurse, Junior ROTC Instructor, *Driver and Traffic Safety Education (in-vehicle instruction only)* and Work-Based Learning Coordinator, endorsements need not meet the requirements of sections 5233 and 5235 of these rules. However, individuals holding endorsement(s) in one or more of these areas who do not have documentation of the required student teaching or administrator experience (5233) and cannot demonstrate competency with the Core Teaching or Leadership Standards (5235), must meet these requirements in order to qualify for additional endorsements in any other teaching or administrative area.
